RULES

- 1 The Judges decision is final.
- 2 The committee accept no responsibility whatsoever for loss, injury or damage to any person or their property whilst on the Showground.
- 3 NO nomination or substitute entries will be accepted.
- 4 NO entry fee will be refunded.
- 5 The committee reserves the right to amend the schedule and to refuse entries at their discretion.
- 6 Objections to be lodged in writing within 30 minutes of the event, with a deposit of £50, which will be returned if the objection is upheld.
- 7 Anyone found to be abusive in any form will be excluded from the show ground.
- 8 A rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Staffordshire Branch Member in every class, gold armbands must be worn.
- 9 Anyone found mistreating a horse or pony will be asked to leave the showground, and reported to the appropriate body.
- 10 ANY PONY TAKING PART IS LIABLE TO DOPE TESTING
- 11 Any stallions or colts must be led or ridden by an attendant/rider of 14 years old and over.
- 12 ALL riders must be suitably mounted.

NPS Winter Championship Qualifying Rounds

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to Members and Non-Members of the NPS, but Non-Members will need to become members to enter the finals at the NPS Spring Festival 2025.

The NPS General Rules for Showing apply (see NPS website for details).

In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify. Winnings in the 2024/2025

Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2025 Mountain and Moorland Novice Ridden competitions. Qualification cards will be awarded in the ring.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

The organisers will take any necessary precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of persons on the Showground. It is a condition of entry to the Showground that all persons will act on any instructions given to them by the show committee, in so far that it can effect the health and safety of all. All competitors must take due care to section 7 of the Health and Safety Act and have due regard for the safety of others. There is a Health and Safety Statement on display at the Secretary's Office.

Dogs must be kept on leads at all times. Horses must not be left tied to horse boxes.

Entry Fees: All entries are via Entry-master & include first aid. Closing Date Wednesday 9th April 2025. In-Hand Classes, £12 Members & £15 non-members, Ridden Classes £17 Members & £20.00 non-members, RIHS £35 members and £40 non-members (including the RIHS Levi @ £12) Prize money of £25 for class winners in RIHS classes Entries will be taken on the day, £10 extra on the day for all classes bar RIHS £20 extra for RIHS classes – CASH ONLY

Clashing of Classes.

Whilst every endeavour has been made with the timetable to accommodate everyone, clashing is sometimes unavoidable. Therefore, classes will not be held up - so please bear this in mind when entering, as entry fees are not refundable.

It is recommended that every animal at the show has third party insurance

** This show is a qualifier for the N.C.P.A. Pony of the Year Show First, second, and third prize winners in appropriate classes will qualify ** Also a qualifier for NCPA TOPLINE HORSEBOXES Junior Mountain & Moorland Pony of the Year the highest placed juniors in classes 3 to 8 will qualify.

The Champion and Reserve Champion from the Riding Pony Breeding, Hunter Pony Breeding and Mountain & Moorland In Hand Classes will qualify for the Final to be held on Monday 25th August 2025 at the NPS Area 4 Summer Show. Qualifiers do not have to be Members of the NPS.

NPS M&M PURE NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book.

Pony not to have been placed first in any Ridden Mountain & Moorland Class (excluding Lead Rein or First Ridden) before 1st September in the current season All ponies in this class must be shown in a snaffle bit. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules).

- Class 3 Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A & B
- Class 4 Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C & D

NPS/CASTLEFORD STUD M&M CONFINED NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book. Pony not to have won a first prize of $\pounds 10$ or more in any open Ridden M&M Class before 1st September in the current season. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules)

Class 5 Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A & B Class 6 Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C & D

TO BE JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES OF UK PONIES & HORSES LIMITED. Owners must be Adult / Life Members, Riders must be current UK Ponies & Horses Limited Annual Members and the ponies currently registered with UK Ponies & Horses Limited before time of entry in order to compete in these classes

Open to Mountain and Moorland Ridden Stallion (Intermediate class only), Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over.

Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C or D.

The highest placed exhibit not already qualified within the first five will qualify for the UK Ponies & Horses Limited RIHS Young Riders M&M Ridden.

The highest placed pony and rider not already qualified within the first five will qualify for the UK Ponies & Horses Limited RIHS Amateur Riders M&M Finals at the RIHS Hickstead in July 2025. Qualification will be verified by the office. Only 1st & 2nd prize winners from the Large Breeds, Small Breeds & the Intermediate Section will be eligible for the UK Ponies & Horses Limited Championship. All three sections must be included in the Championship.

- Class 9 RIHS UK Ponies & Horses Limited & Anthony Evans Insurance Brokers Intermediate M&M – Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old & over. Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society stud books of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh Section A, B, C or D. Rider not to have attained their 25th Birthday before the 1st January in the current year. (See Rule 7 of the current UK Ponies & Horses Limited Rule Book).
- Class 10 RIHS UK Ponies & Horses Limited & Anthony Evans Insurance M&M Large Breeds Mare or Gelding, 4 years old & over Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society stud books of Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highland, New Forest, Welsh Section C or D. Rider not to have attained their 18th Birthday before the 1st January in the current year.
- Class 11 RIHS UK Ponies & Horses Limited & Anthony Evans Insurance M&M Small Breeds Mare or Gelding 4 years old & over Registered in their approved Pure Breed Society stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Section A or B. Rider not to have attained their 14th Birthday before the 1st January in the current year.

Championship for the 1st & 2nd prize winners from classes 9-11

Class 12 RIHS UK Ponies & Horses Limited& Anthony Evans Insurance Amateur Rider Ridden M&M – Mountain and Moorland ridden Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over, registered in their approved Pure Breed Society stud Books of Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fells Highland, New Forest, Shetland , Welsh A,B.C,D rider any age. UK Ponies & Horses Limited Mini Juniors – Mountain & Moorland Small Breeds only, registered in their approved Pure Breed Society Stud Books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Section A or B. Mare or Gelding 4 years old or over. Riders to have attained their 8th birthday but not their 13th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year. Combinations would not be required to become a Member of UK Ponies Horses to compete in this class.

NPS M&M IN-HAND CHAMPIONSHIP

This Competition is open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. At Foal Shows, the first three ponies in each class will qualify for the Yearling Final at the Spring Festival.

Pony not to have won a first prize in any Leading Rein class before 1st September in the current season. To be shown in a snaffle bit, the leading rein must be attached to the noseband only. The reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hands. Riders must not have attained their 9th birthday by 1st January in the current year.

Class 26 This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book. Not exceeding 128cms. Pony not to have won a first prize in any First Ridden class before 1st September in the current season. Ponies must not be cantered except in their individual show. Riders must not have attained their 12th birthday by 1st January in the current year.

Class 27 This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book. Not exceeding 122cms. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bit, the leading rein to be attached to the noseband only. The reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hands. Riders must not have attained their 9th birthday by 1st January in the current year.

NPS/M&M FIRST RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

Class 28 This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book. Not exceeding 128cms. Riders must not have attained their 12th birthday by 1st January in the current year.
